Last night, I met with a small group consisting of the Principal's Advisory Council members and our School Board president. We did a lot of initial brainstorming and discussion around what our reopening could look like. We will be adding members to this group as we move forward. Our goal is to get all students into the building following prescribed safety guidelines (like 6 foot distancing) which will require some creative planning. We also have to realize that in a blink of an eye, we could all be sent home and return to remote learning. We have to be ready for that too.

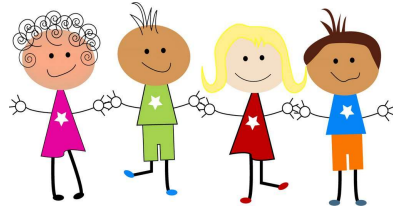

- August 24-28: Staff Preparation
